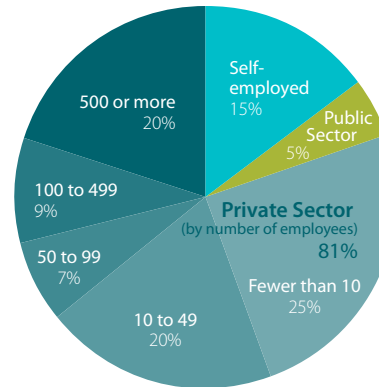

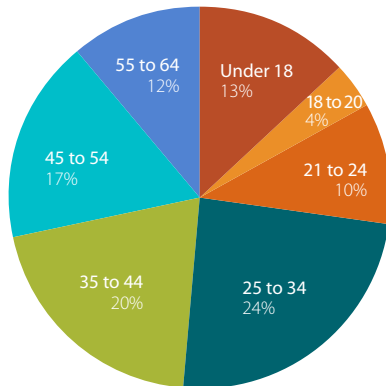

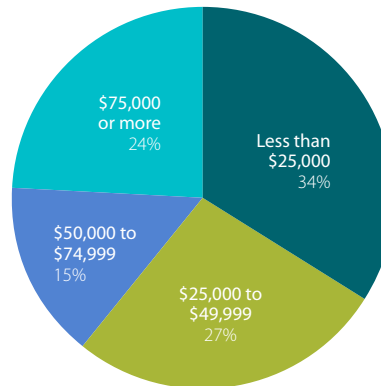

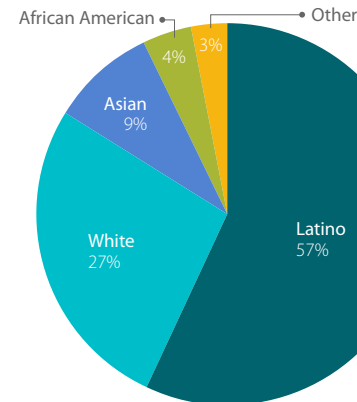

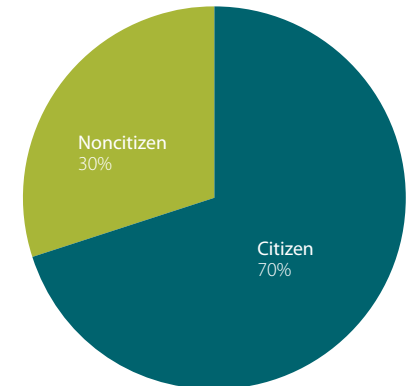
FAMILY INCOME

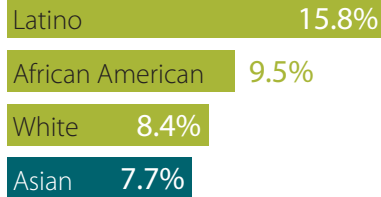
WHAT IS THE LIKELIHOOD OF BEING UNINSURED?

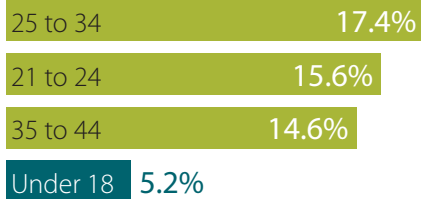
Employer Size and Type*



Race/Ethnicity



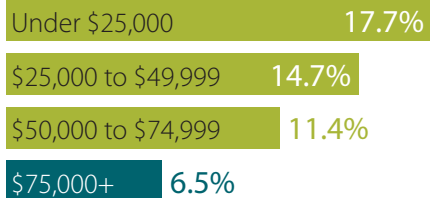
Age Group
