California Opioid Overdose Surveillance Dashboard

The California Department of Public Health, Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development, and Department of Justice collaborated to create and manage the California Opioid Overdose Surveillance Dashboard, with support from the California Health Care Foundation. The goal is to provide enhanced visualization and integration of statewide and geographically specific, fatal and nonfatal, opioid-related overdose and opioid prescription data. Users can track short- and long-term goals targeted by California's Prescription Drug Overdose Prevention program.




