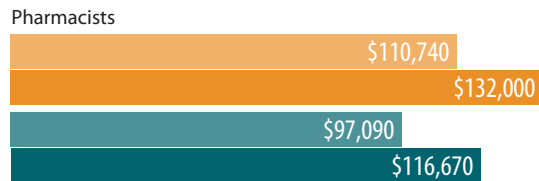

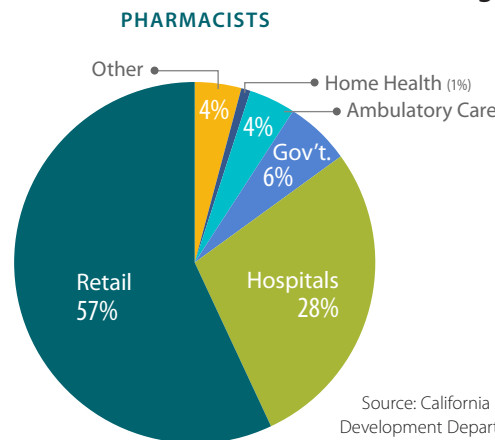

Real Median Wages, 2001 vs. 2012



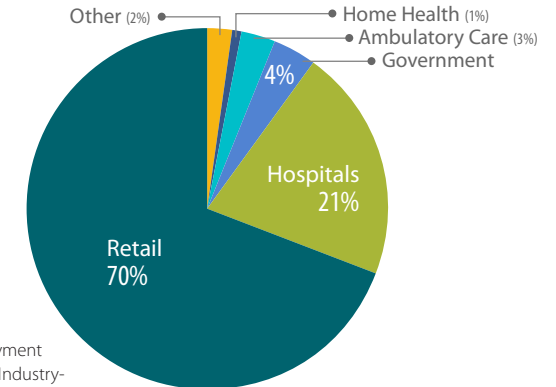

Work Setting, 2010

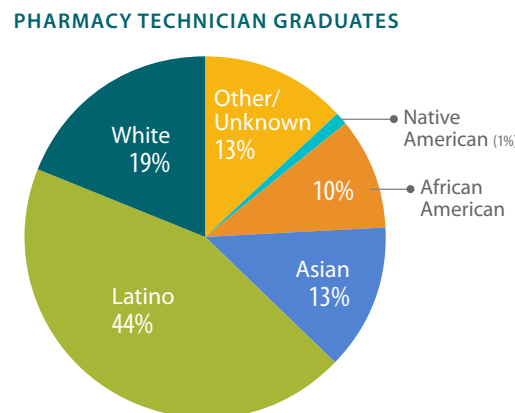
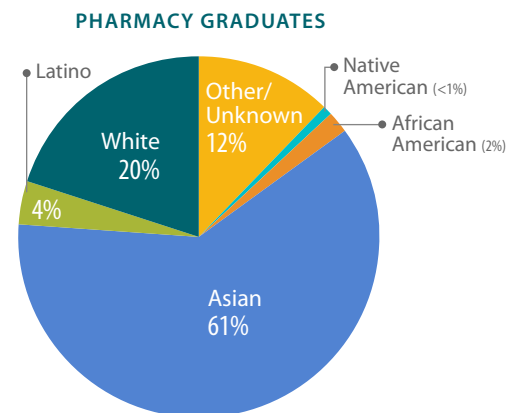

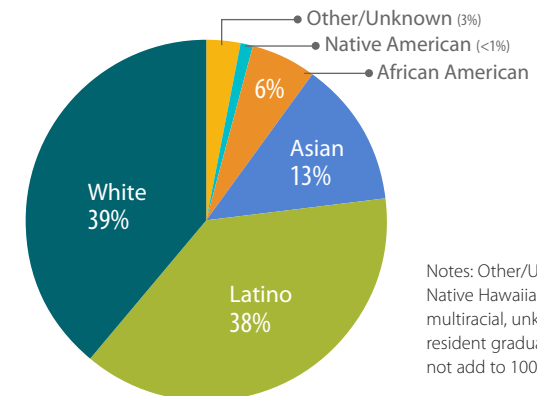
