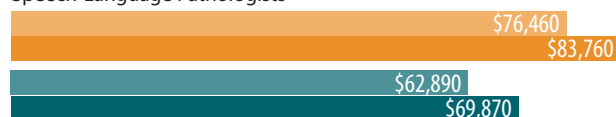

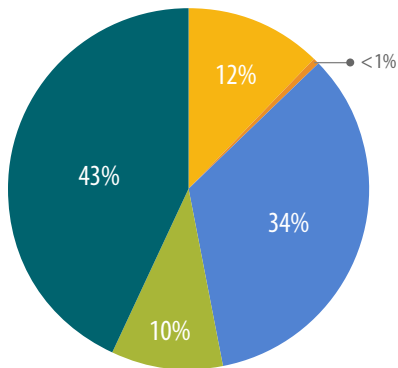

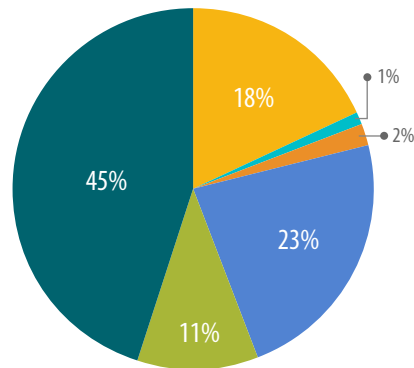

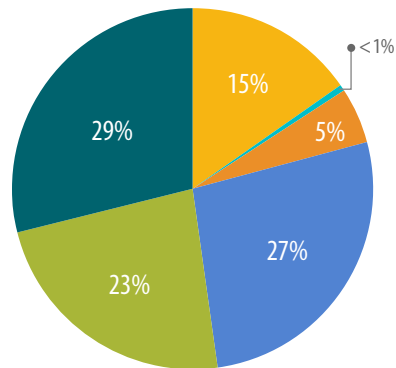

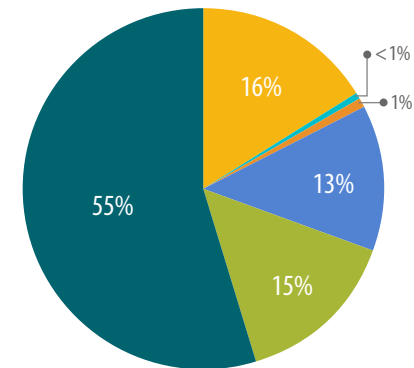

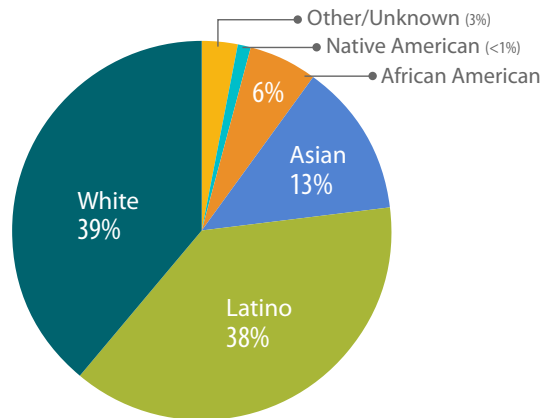
RESPIRATORY THERAPISTS
