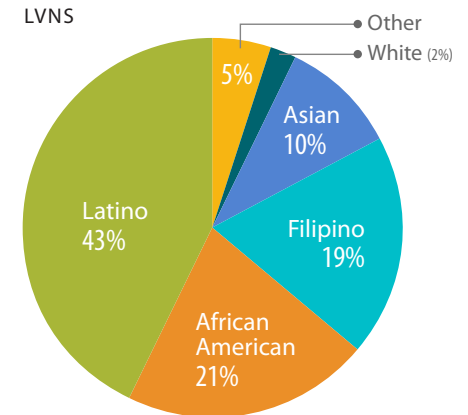

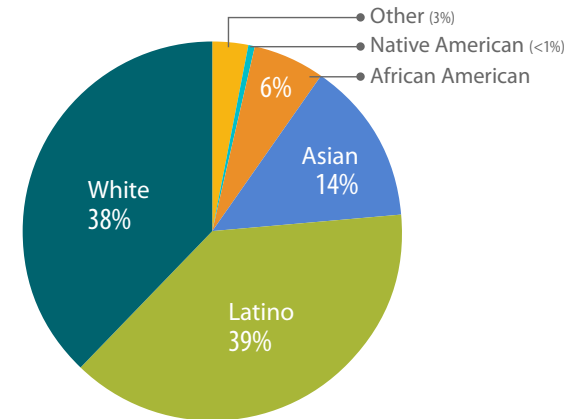

Race/Ethnicity, 2015

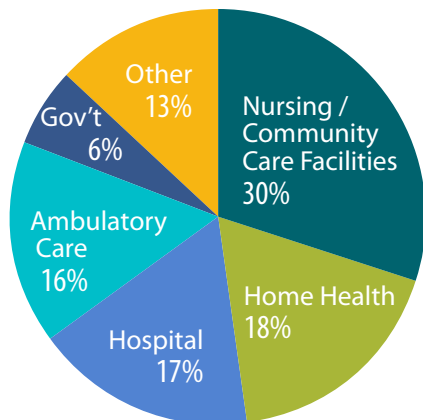


TOTAL CALIFORNIA POPULATION

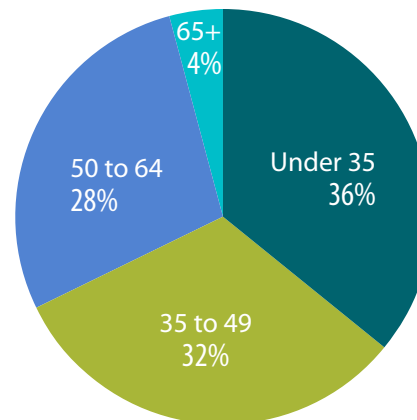
