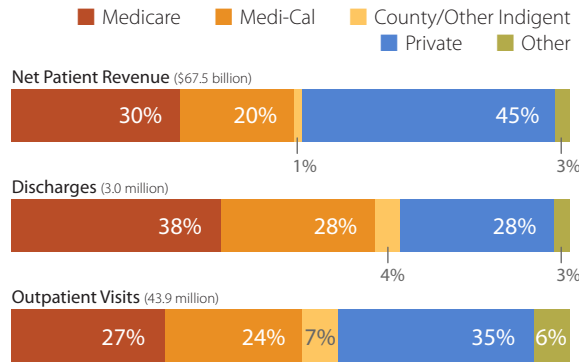

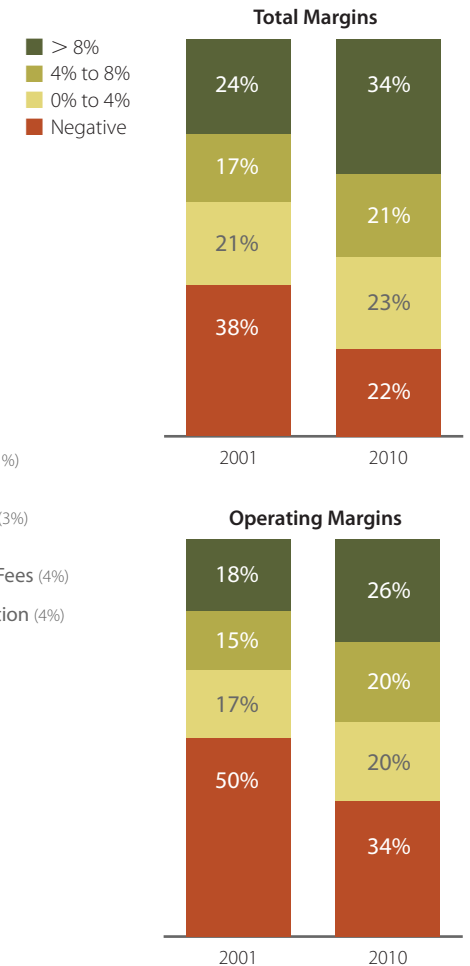
NET PATIENT REVENUE, DISCHARGES, AND OUTPATIENT VISITS, BY PAYER, 2010
