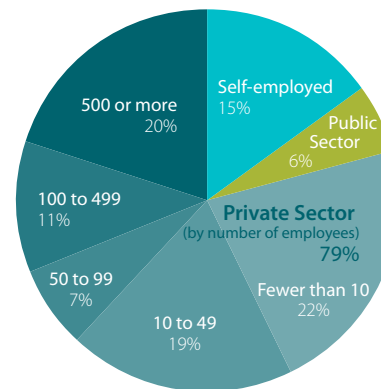

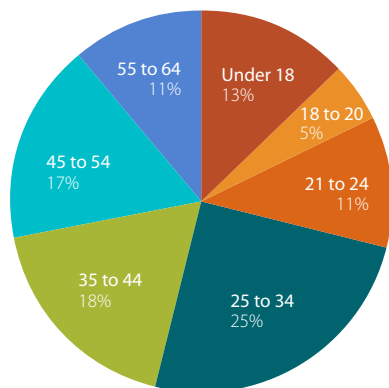

EMPLOYER SIZE AND TYPE[‡]

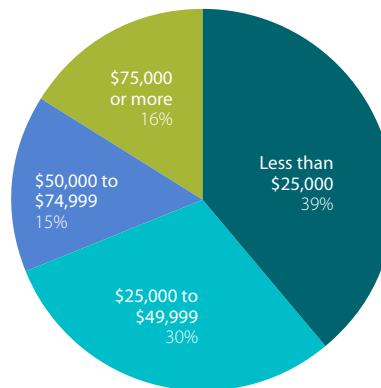

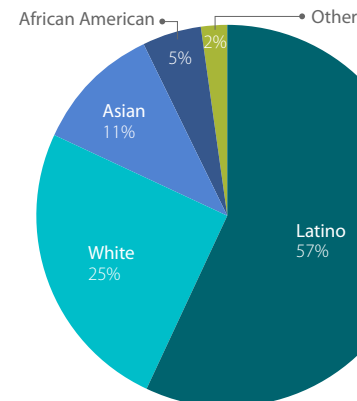
AGE GROUP



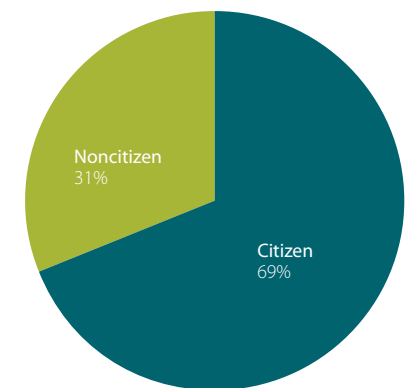
FAMILY INCOME



RACE/ETHNICITY



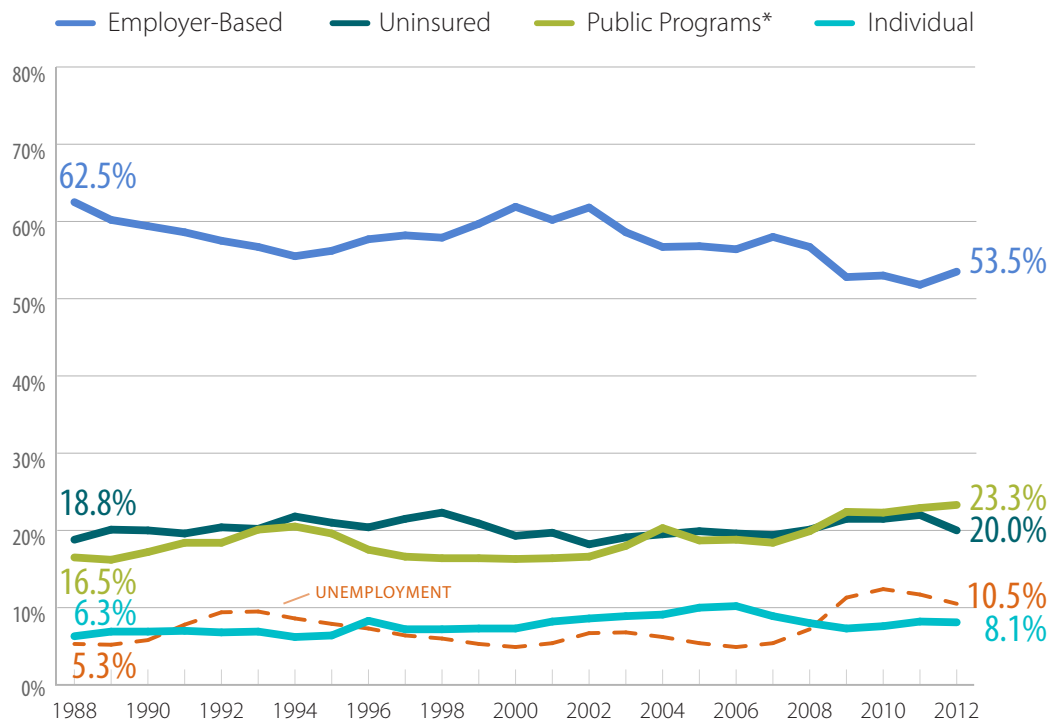

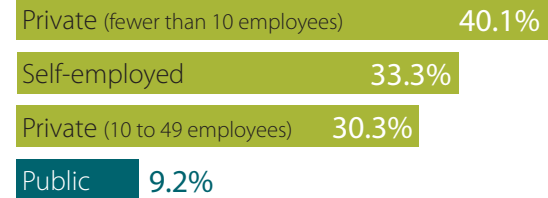

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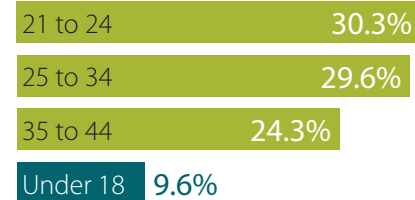
UNINSURED, BY DEMOGRAPHIC GROUP, 2012

■ Least Likely

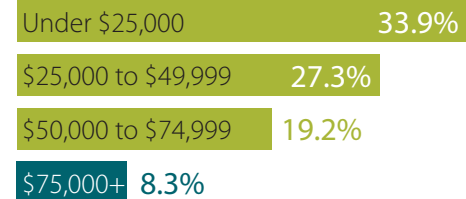
By Employer Size and Type



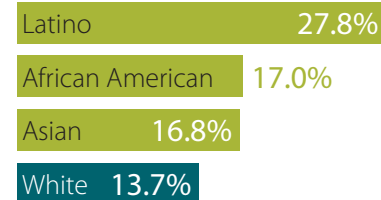
By Age
