


THE FACTS IN

BLACK & WHITE

AFRICAN AMERICANS ARE MORE LIKELY TO GET PROSTATE CANCER, AND TWO TIMES MORE LIKELY TO DIE FROM IT THAN ARE WENTES.



WHILE WHITES ARE MORE LIKELY TO BE DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST CANCER, AFRICAN AMERICANS'
DEATH RATE FROM THE DISEASE IS 40% HIGHER.



Note: Rates are age-adjusted to the 2000 U.S. Standard Million Population. Cases are new cases and exclude in situ cancers. The Veterans Health Administration did not report cancer cases to CCR in 2005–2009; therefore, incidence counts for adult males in 2005–2009 are underestimated and should be interpreted with caution.
