

Our Mission

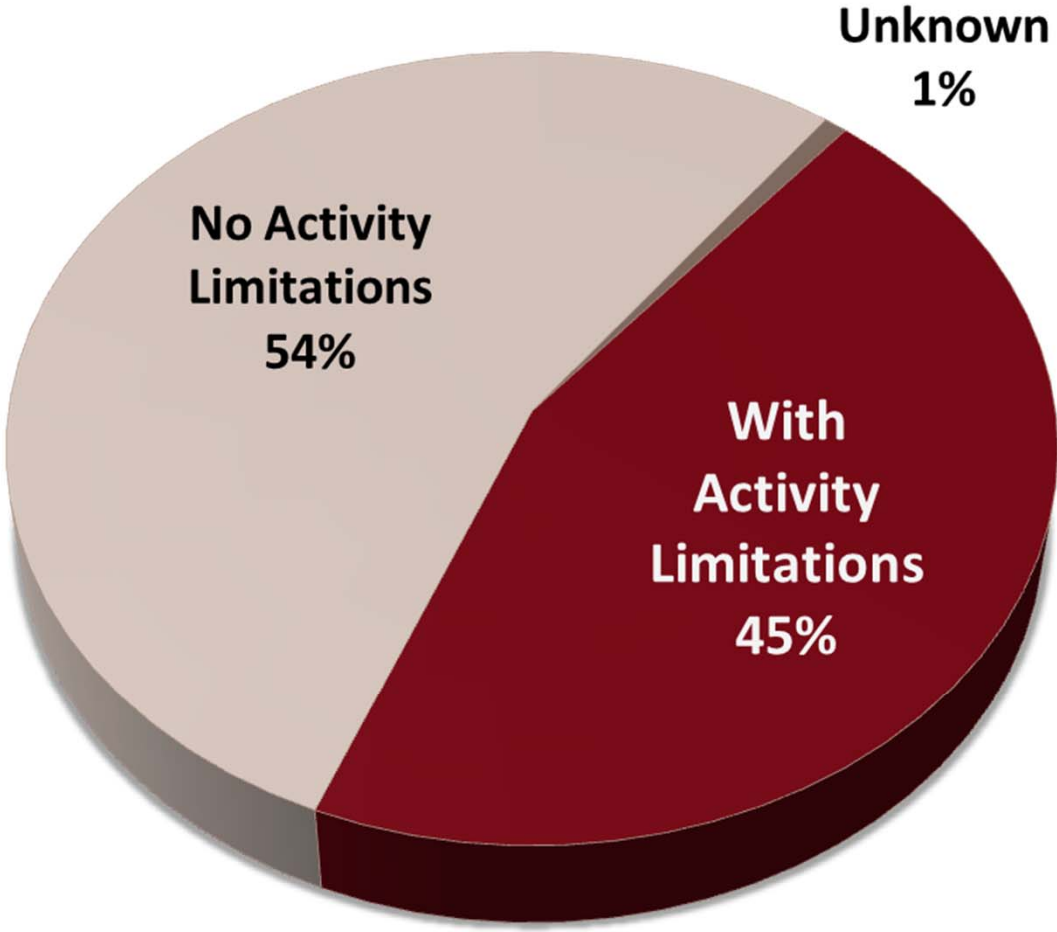
To advance a coordinated and easily navigated system of high-quality services for older adults that preserve dignity and independence.

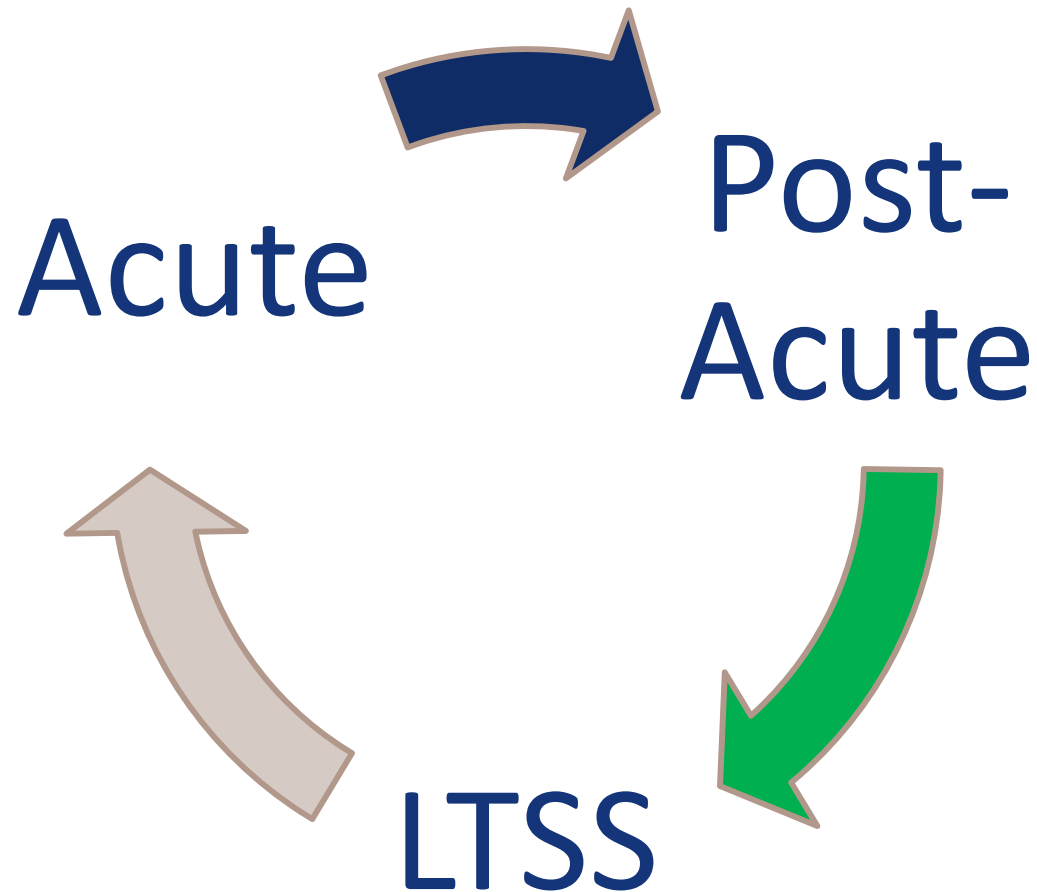

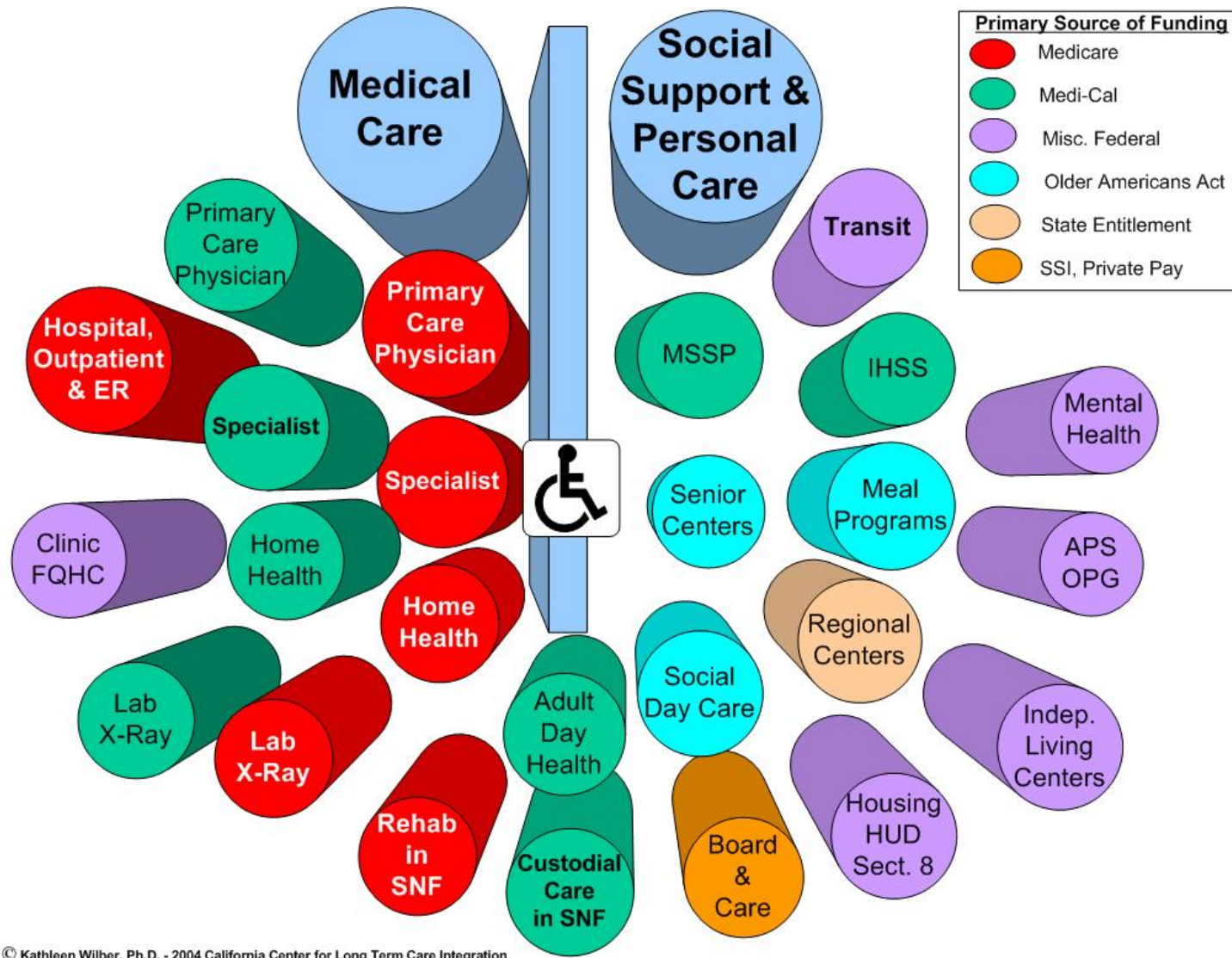
