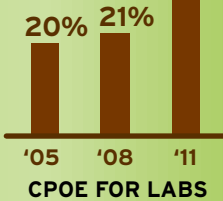
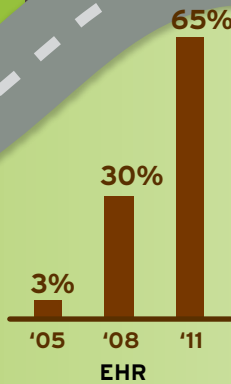

HIT PENETRATION VARIES BY TYPE OF TECHNOLOGY



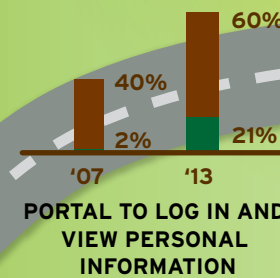
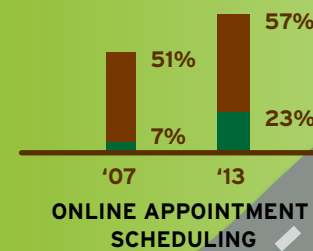

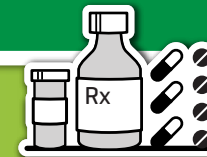

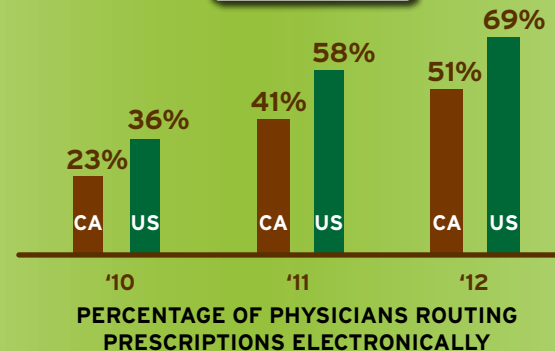
