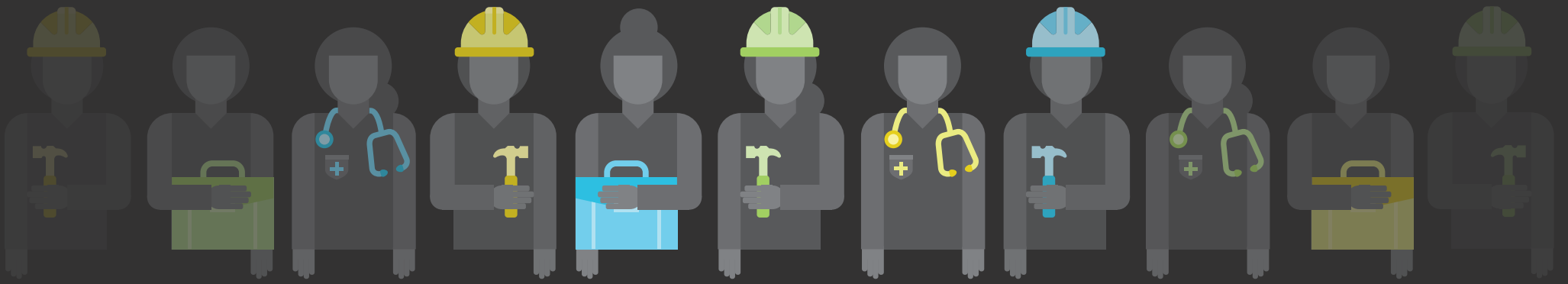
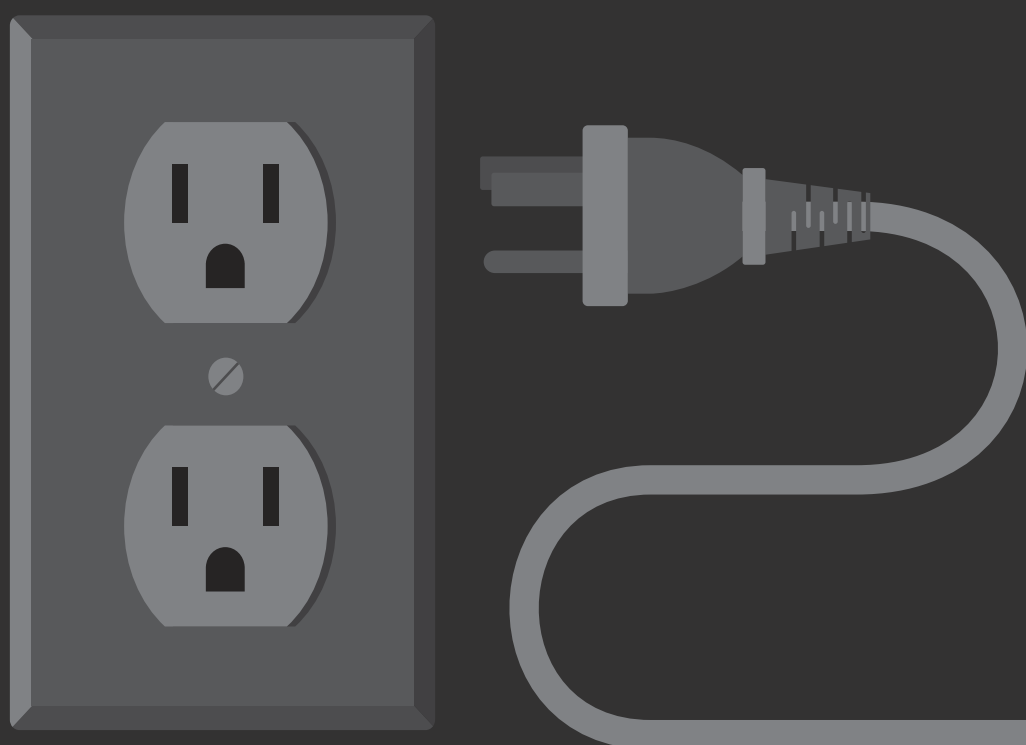


COULD Pulling the Plug ON THE ACA Hurt the Health OF California's Economy?
