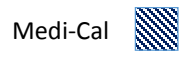


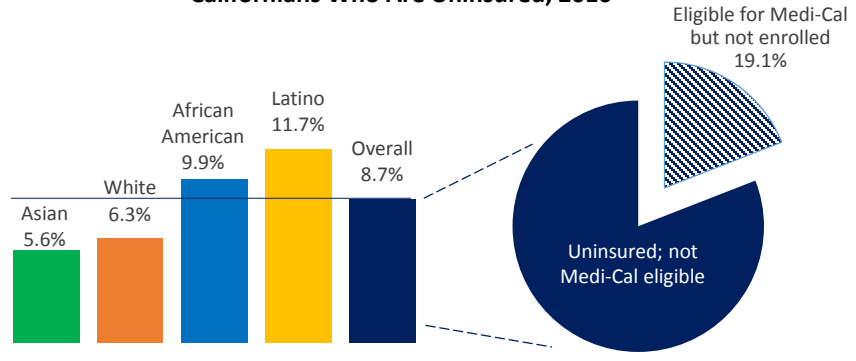

Californians Who Are Uninsured, 2016

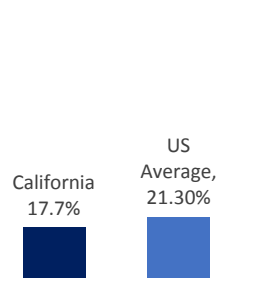

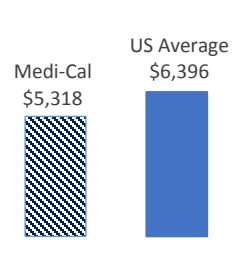
Affordability/Cost of Health Care

People with High Health Care Cost Burden,* 2016



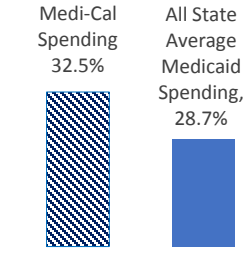

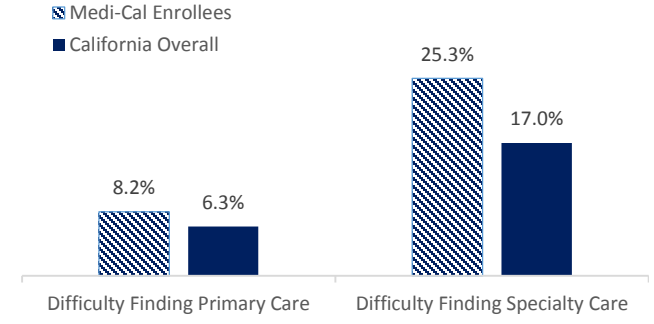
Medicaid Spending as Percentage of Total State Spending, 2016

California Deaths That Occur in the Hospital



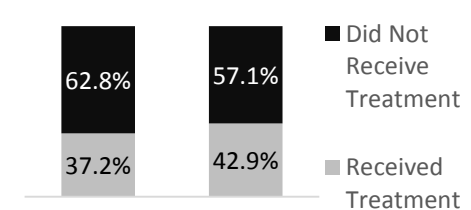

Change in Opioid Overdose Death Rates, 2015 to 2016



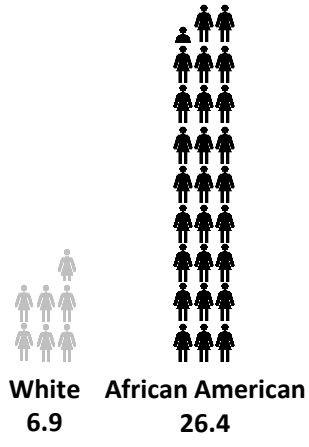
